### **Hajj Pilgrimage to Mecca**

Information is available from the National Fraud Intelligence Bureau on what to do if you have been the victim of Hajj Fraud. It provides information on how to prevent being a victim to fraud and what to do if you are a victim. Up to twenty five thousand British Muslims travel for Hajj each year, only ten percent of Hajj Fraud is reported, according to The Association of British Hujjaj (Pilgrims) UK.
